1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. Role and Functions

The Sansthan was established in October, 1970 as an autonomous organisation registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (Act XXI of 1860) for the development and promotion of Sanskrit all over the country. It is fully funded by Government of India. It functions as an apex body for the propagation and development of Sanskrit and assists the Ministry of Human Resource Development in formulating and implementing various plans and schemes for the development of Sanskrit studies. It has assumed the role of a nodal body for the effective implementation of various recommendations made by the Sanskrit Commission set up by the Government of India, Ministry of Education in 1956 to consider the propagation and development of Sanskrit language and education in all its aspects.

The major objectives of the Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan as indicated in the Memorandum of Association are to propagate, develop and encourage Sanskrit learning and research and to serve as a central administrative and coordinating machinery for the management of all the Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeethas established or taken over.

1.2. Programmes and activities

For the realisation of its objectives, the Sansthan undertakes the following programmes and activities:-

- Establishes Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeethas in different States.
- Conducts teaching of Sanskrit on traditional lines at Secondary, Under-graduate, Graduate, Post-graduate and Doctorate levels.
- Conducts teachers' training at graduate level i.e. B. Ed.
- Conducts and coordinates research work in various disciplines of Sanskrit learning.
- Cooperates with other organisations in sponsoring joint projects of common interest.
- Establishes Sanskrit libraries, manuscripts collection centres and also edits and publishes rare manuscripts and books of importance.

1.3 Teaching

Teaching is conducted from Prak Shastri to Acharya levels on the basis of syllabus drawn up by the Sansthan in its constituent Vidyapeethas. Sanskrit institutions, managed by voluntary organisations and affiliated to the Sansthan, also impart teaching with the same syllabus. In all the Vidyapeethas, there is a two year buffer course of plus-two level called Prak Shastri to facilitate students who come from non-traditional system of Sanskrit education.

In Puri and Jammu Vidyapeethas, there is also school level teaching, beginning from Prathama (Classes VI, VII and VIII), upto Purva Madhyama and Uttar Madhyama.

Presently, Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan is administering seven Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeethas.

1.4. Teachers' training

In the Kendriya Vidyapeethas teachers' training of one academic year with emphasis on practice teaching, is conducted leading to the award of Shiksha Shastri Degree, which is equivalent to B.Ed. in Sanskrit.

1.5. Research .

Ganga Nath Jha Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Allahabad is exclusively meant for carrying out research in selected branches. But facilities exist in all the Vidyapeethas for students to enrol themselves for research on successful completion of which the degree of Vidyavaridhi, which is equivalent to Ph.D., is awarded to them.

1.6. Publications

The Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan brings out two research journals, namely 'Sanskrit Vimarsha' and 'Ganganath Jha Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha Research Journal'. While the first journal is brought out by the Sansthan Headquarters office, the other is published by Ganganath Jha Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Allahabad.

2. ORGANISATION AND ESTABLISHMENT

The General Body is the policy making body of the Sansthan and consists of 20 members. The members of General Body of Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan are annexed hereto and marked as Annexure 'A'. The Shasi Parishad is the apex Governing Council and has six members besides the Adhyaksha and Upadhyaksha. Shasi Parishad implements the policies laid down by General Body. The composition of present Shasi Parishad is annexed hereto and marked as Annexure 'B'.

The following Committees/Councils assist the Shasi Parishad in the discharge of its duties.

1. Artha Samiti (Finance Committee)
2. Vidya Parishad (Academic Council)
3. Prakashan Samiti (Publication Committee)
4. Shodha Samiti (Research Committee)
5. Pariksha Mandal (Examination Board)

The Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan functions through four Wings:---

1. Academic Wing
2. Examination Wing
3. Administrative Wing
4. Finance Wing

The Academic Wing consists of three branches viz.

- (i) Academic Branch
- (ii) Research & Publication Branch
- (iii) Correspondence Course Branch

Each of these branches is headed by a Deputy Director. All these officers assist the Director of the Sansthan, who is the Principal Executive Officer responsible for the execution of policies and programmes approved by the General Body and Shasi Parishad. The Director of the Sansthan is appointed by the Government of India.

2-1 ACADEMIC WING

It consists of three branches:---

2.1.1 Academic Branch

This Unit is mainly responsible for laying down standards for academic performance, preparation of calendar of the academic programme and for designing

the syllabi for various courses. In addition, it also handles the work of affiliation of institutions and award of scholarships.

2.1.2. Research And Publication Branch

This Unit is concerned with implementation and coordination of Research and Publication activities of the constituent Vidyapeethas and of the Research and Publication programmes and projects of the Sansthan.

2.1.3. Correspondence Course Branch

This Unit is responsible for the organisation of Correspondence Course. These courses are offered at two-levels, viz.

- i) Introductory Course in Sanskrit
Ist year (Hindi & English Medium)
- ii) Introductory Course in Sanskrit 2nd year
(Hindi & English Medium)

2.2 EXAMINATION WING

The Examination wing organises Annual and Supplementary examinations for the following courses :—

A competitive entrance test is being held for admission to Shiksha Shastri course by the Sansthan. It is known as Pre-Shiksha Shastri Test (PSST).

It also arranges evaluation of thesis and viva-voce examination for awarding research degrees Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) to the students of Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeethas and affiliated institutions.

2.3 ADMINISTRATION WING

The Administration Wing deals with general administration of the Sansthan and its constituent Vidyapeethas. It also plans appointments, postings, transfers and other establishment matters. Control over Vidyapeethas is also one of the main responsibilities of the Section.

2.4 FINANCE WING

This Section is concerned with the preparation of budget, receipt and distribution of grants to financial management and preparation of annual accounts etc. It also manages provident funds and arranges for disbursement of scholarships awarded under the scheme of the scholarships.

2.5 VIDYAPEETHAS

The following Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeethas are being administered by Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan.

The School Section from Prathama to Uttarmadhyama is being run only in Puri and Jammu Vidyapeethas while Prak-Shastri, though a part of the School Section itself, being a buffer course, is attached to all Vidyapeethas.

3. ACADEMIC WING

3.1 Academic Branch

This Section is headed by a Deputy Director. During the year under report it is running with the following staff:

1. One Section Officer
2. One Research Assistant
3. One T. G. T.
4. One Assistant
5. One U.D.C.
6. Two L.D. C.s
7. Two Class IV

This Section is concerned with the following activities:—

- (a) It is the Chief Organiser of the academic activities of the Sansthan and frames the syllabi for various courses.

Separate subject committees are constituted to frame syllabi of difference subject from Prathama to Acharya. This is referred to Board of Studies constituted as and when required for scrutiny.

However, as regards English, Hindi and modern subjects like History etc. at school level, the syllabi of the C.B.S.E. are adopted. As regards the syllabi for modern subjects, viz. Hindi and English for Shastri Classes, the syllabi of Delhi University is normally followed.

- (b) Scholarships

The Scholarship unit deals with two types of scholarships. One is connected with the award of scholarship to the Vidyapeetha students. This is done within the budget provision of each Vidyapeetha. The following is the break-down of award of scholarship of the students of our constituent Vidyapeethas during 1995-96:-

(e) Affiliation to Institutions

The Sansthan had started with a few Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeethas but later a few private institutions were affiliated. The number of affiliated institutions has gone up considerably over the last few years. The list of institutions affiliated to the Sansthan is given at Annexure 'C'. These private institutions are affiliated only for the general courses from Prathama to Acharya and Vidyavaridhi.

3.2 Research & Publication Branch

The Research and Publication Unit is headed by a Deputy Director. During the year under report, it is running with the following staff:—

1. Two Research Assistants
2. Two Assistants
3. One U.D.C.
5. Two L.D.C.s
4. One Library Assistant
6. One Library Attendant
7. One Group 'D'

It is responsible for the co-ordination of Research and Publication work of the Headquarters Office and the Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeethas. Besides, it is also entrusted with the work of implementation of the following schemes transferred from the Ministry:-

1. Production of Sanskrit literature including News Papers and Journals.
2. Purchase of Sanskrit books including reprint of out of print rare books.
3. Purchase and publication of manuscripts.

During the year, the Grant-in-aid Committee met thrice and approved large number of proposals. The Publication Committee met once and approved important publication proposals of the Vidyapeetha. The research Sub-Committee constituted by the Research Board also met once and framed rules for Sansthan's Vidyāvāchaspati (D.Litt.) Degree.

Srinagar Centre of Kashmir Shaivism is being run by the Jammu Vidyapeetha. More than one hundred manuscripts on Kashmir Shaiva Darshana have been collected and editing work on some of these collections is in progress. The Kashmir Shaiva Darshana Kosha is also under print.

Besides, an annual grant of Rs. 1,79,400/- for editing and publishing of critical edition of Mahapuranas was provided to All India Kashiraj Trust, Varanasi (Purana Vibhag)

3.3 Correspondence Course Branch

The Correspondence Course Unit was established as a separate Unit under the Academic Wing and for more than 10 years, this Unit has been organising Sanskrit language teaching at preliminary stage through correspondence in both English and Hindi medium. This course is divided into two levels of 21 lessons each and is covered in maximum period of two years.

During the year 1995 i.e. for the Correspondence Course from January to December, 1995, students were enrolled for these two courses, as per details given below:-

Among these, twenty six students are from abroad.

The Course is being organised at a nominal annual fee of Rs. 50/- per student, residing in India; and US \$ 20 student, living abroad.

In order to make these courses more popular and to enable a large number of aspirants to avail of this facility, a number of steps were taken by the Sansthan to give wide publicity in English and vernacular through the Directorate of Audio-Visual Publicity. As a result of these efforts, in addition to young students, a number of high ranking officers and people in various avocations have registered themselves with the Sansthan and are learning Sanskrit through the Correspondence Courses.

Those who complete these courses successfully are given certificate titled 'Sanskrit Pravesha'.

4. EXAMINATION WING

The Examination Section is headed by the Deputy Controller (Examination) with a three tier staffing pattern. It is mainly responsible for the evaluation of examination papers of the Sansthan. Various examinations, such as Prathama to Acharya, Shiksha-Shastri and Vidyavaridhi are conducted by the Sansthan. In these examinations, students both from the constituent Vidyapeethas as well as the affiliated institutions, are admitted. These examinations are conducted in accordance with the guidelines laid down by the Academic Council and the syllabi laid down for the purpose.

In addition to above, 50 candidates have been declared successful for award of Vidyavaridhi degree during 1995-96.

Like previous years, the PSST (Pre-Shiksha Shastri Test) was also held during 1995-96 for admission of students in Shiksha Shastri Course in the different Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeethas under Sansthan.

5. ADMINISTRATION WING

The Section is headed by a Deputy Director. During the year under report, it was running with the following staff:-

1. One Section Officer
2. Three Assistants
3. One U.D.C.s
4. Four L.D.C.s

The Administration Section in the Headquarters Office of the Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan is performing its functions of house-keeping in accordance with rules, regulations and procedure. It also provides necessary establishment support to the various constituent Vidyapeethas of the Sansthan for their effective and efficient functioning. This branch mainly deals with general administration, establishment matters, services and supplies and acquisition of land & building, Shasi Parishad and General Body of the Sansthan.

Efforts have been made to acquire land and for the construction of buildings for Vidyapeethas which do not have their own buildings. Such as Vidyapeethas at Jammu, Jaipur, Lucknow, Puri, Guruvayoor and Sriingeri.

6. FINANCE WING

This Section is headed by the Deputy Director (Finance) and comprises one Accounts Officer, one Assistant, one U.D.C. and three L.D.C.s including one Cashier.

Budget (1995-96)

An un-utilized balance of Rs. 70.87 lakhs was carried over from the year 1994-95 to the financial year 1995-96. A total budget of Rs.920.22 lakhs (including the previous upspent balance) was sanctioned by the Ministry. The amount was further allocated among the constituent units in the following manner:-

These funds were utilised during the year on pay and allowances, scholarships and other maintenance items of expenditure. An unspent balance of Rs. 10.81 lakhs (Plan 6.94 lakhs and non-plan Rs. 3.87 lakhs).

Accounts

While the accounts of the constituent Vidyapeethas were duly audited and certified by the respective Accountant General during the year itself. The consolidated accounts for 1995-96 has already been audited by D.G.A.C.R from

4-12-96 to 16-1-97, but audit report is still awaited. The consolidated Receipt and Payment Accounts are placed at Annexure 'F'.

Maintenance of Provident Fund Accounts

The Section has maintained pay and provident fund accounts for officers and members of the staff of the Headquarters' Office. Every member was supplied with the annual provident fund account statement immediately after the close of the financial year.

Pursuit of Audit Objections

Concerted efforts were made during the year to get the audit objections settled. For this purpose, the individual Vidyapeethas were directed to take necessary corrective measures and replies of compliance were sent to the audit authorities with the result that a number of audit objections were got settled during the year.

7. SCHEME SECTION

The Sansthan is implementing various schemes transferred by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India for promotion and propagation of Sanskrit language and literature, viz.

(i) Financial Assistance to Voluntary Sanskrit Organisations

Under this scheme, selected organisations are sanctioned financial assistance i.e. salary to Sanskrit teachers, scholarship to students, Library grants and construction of school buildings. An amount of Rs. 109.5 lakhs under Plan and Rs. 25 lakhs under Non-Plan was incurred under this scheme by the Sansthan.

(ii) Adrash Sanskrit Mahavidyalaya/Shodh Sansthan

Under this scheme 16 institutions are being run in various parts of the country under the Sansthan. An amount of Rs.53 lakhs under Plan and Rs. 102.52 lakhs under Non-Plan (Total Rs. 155.52 Lakhs) was provided by the Sansthan to these institution during the period under report.

(iii) Shastra Chudamani Scheme

Under this Scheme, the services of retired eminent Sanskrit scholars are utilised in Adarsh Sanskrit Pathshalas and other State Government-run Sanskrit Colleges and voluntary organisations.

The object of the Scheme is to preserve the indepth studies of different subjects relating to Shastras in Sanskrit at the various centres where Sanskrit education is imparted to the Sanskrit students of traditional system. As per the scheme, the traditional scholars are appointed in the different organisations. A sum of Rs. 11 lakhs under plan has been sanctioned by Government of India under this scheme. An amount of Rs.1,000/-p.m. is paid to a scholar initially for a period for two years. The appointment so made may be extended for another one year as per the recommendation of the Grants-in-aid Committee.

During the year under report i.e. 1995-96, 21 Shastra Chudamani scholars under the scheme were appointed by the Sansthan initially for a period of 2 years. Besides, an extension of one year was also granted to 24 scholars under the scheme. At present, total 125 scholars are working under this scheme.

(iv) **Vocational Training Scheme**

Under this scheme, selected organisations are sanctioned financial assistance to organise the workshop and to conduct prayogik Prashikshan in vocational disciplines like Jyotish, Karmakanda, Paleography, Cataloguing, Manuscriptology, Sanskrit Shorthand and Typing etc. An amount of Rs. 3 lakhs has been sanctioned under this scheme by Government of India. As per the recommendations of Grant-in-aid Committee, 18 institutions were recommended for financial assistance during the year 1995-96.

(v) **Sanskrit Dictionary Project:**

The project to prepare a Sanskrit Dictionary on historical principles spanning the period from 1500 B.C. upto 1900 A.D. has been undertaken by Deccan College, Poona. The project was started in the year 1948 and since then about Re.1 Crore has been spent by Govt. of India. The Department of Sanskrit Dictionary Project, Deccan College, Poona is headed by General Editor and so far the project has brought out 4 volumes comprising 2606 printed pages of the dictionary. With the present progress of the work, it is expected that the dictionary will be completed by the end of 2050 A.D. The project is primarily financed by Govt. of India and to the less extent by Govt. of Maharashtra. During the year 1995-96 a sum of Rs.20 lakhs was sanctioned to Sanskrit Dictionary Project by the Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan.

8. CONSTRUCTION OF SANSTHAN BUILDING

Construction of the office Building of the Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan at Plot No. 56-57 in Institutional Area, Janakpuri, New Delhi :

The building of Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan has been constructed at Plot no. 56-57, Institutional Area, Janakpuri, New Delhi by the CPWD. at an estimated cost of Rs. 2,21,34,750. The foundation stone of the building was laid down by the then Hon'ble Human Resource Development Minister on 1st April, 1994.

9. VIDYAPEETHAS

9.1 Shri Sadashiv Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Puri.

On 15th August, 1971, the former Sadashiva Sanskrit College, Puri, functioning under the state Government with its long association with the study of Sanskrit in traditional form, was taken over by the Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, New Delhi. The old Sadashiva Sanskrit College, Puri was renamed as Sadashiv Kendriya Vidyapeetha, Puri.

The Vidyapeetha imparts teaching from Prathama to Acharya in various Departments like Sahitya, Navya Vyakarana, Dharmashastra, Puranetihas, Jyotish, Advaita Vedanta, Navya Nyaya, Sarva Darshan etc.

Besides the above subjects, modern subjects like English, Hindi, Oriya, History and Maths are also being taught in Shastri and school section classes according to the syllabi of the Sansthan. It also offers Shiksha Shastri (Training) course.

9.2 Gangantha Jha Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Allahabad.

Ganga Nath Jha Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Allahabad is a Research Institute which is a part of the Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan. The Vidyapeetha admits every year a certain number of research scholars to carry out Research work for the Ph.D. (Vidyavaridhi) Degree of the Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan. The scholars, thus enrolled, work under the guidance of one of the members of the academic staff of the Vidyapeetha utilising the facilities available in the Library of the Vidyapeetha as well as in its Manuscripts Wing. The use of the Library and the manuscripts is not limited to the staff and the scholars of the Vidyapeetha. The Vidyapeetha invites scholars and researchers interested in Sanskrit and ancient Indian Culture from all walks of life to make use of its Library subject to its capacity.

All the members of the Academic staff, besides guiding the research work of the students, pursue their own research work assigned to them by the Sansthan. The Research projects of the Vidyapeetha are carried out not only individually but also as team work.

During the year 1995-96, 23 Research scholars were registered for Vidyavaridhi. No SC student was admitted and 10 students have been awarded Ph.D. Degree.

9.3 Shri Ranbir Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Jammu.

Shri Raghunath Sanskrit Mahavidyalaya established by Shri Ranbir Singh, the former Ruler of the J & K was taken over as Shri Ranbir Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha on 1st April, 1971. Students from Prathama to Acharya are taught here in Sahitya, Nyaya Vyakarana, Phalit Jyotisha and Sarva Darshan. Shiksha Shastri was started in 1979 for the training of Sanskrit Teachers. The modern subjects like Hindi, Dogri, English, Political Science and History are taught alongwith the traditional subjects upto Shastri level.

The Vidyapeetha has been entrusted the responsibility of Kashmir Shaiva Darshan Project with the object of compiling a Dictionary of Kashmir Shaiva Darshan.

The Vidyapeetha is running since 14.7.1971 in rented building. The State Government of J & K has allotted land at Bhalwal for the building of the Vidyapeetha and the boundary wall has been constructed.
